



Pump Don't Dump presented the **Hawaii Legislature** with Resolution HCR 58. HCR 58 requests the Sanctuary pass rules to prohibit this sewage dumping. HCR 58 also requests the federal EPA to create a No Discharge Zone. **HCR 58 was passed by the Hawaii Legislature without opposition! The federal government has NOT complied with the Hawaii Legislature's request! Where is Hawaii's Governor?**

Hawaii officials assert that Hawaii has no jurisdiction, because the federal government has pre-empted the state's ability to prohibit dumping. **Therefore it is legal for macerated human sewage and treatment chemicals to be dumped in our stressed ocean and on the endangered animals and where we humans swim, snorkel and paddle.**
